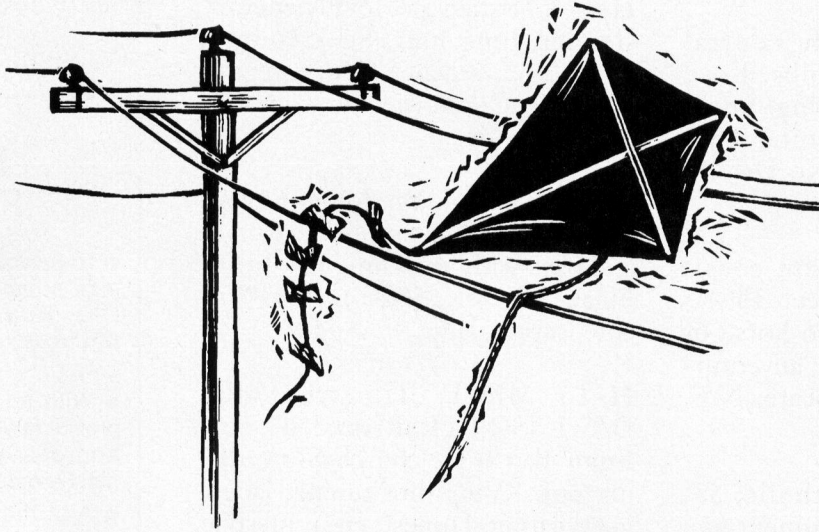


Leave This to the Experts



Removing a kite tangled in power lines is a job best left to utility workers wearing protective gear. If you try to remove it, you run the risk of being electrocuted. When flying a kite, stay away from power lines. Use dry string, and make sure your kite contains absolutely no metal, which conducts electricity. Never fly a kite in stormy or wet weather.
